

## **Exceptions to the OGE Gift Rule available under the Biden Ethics Pledge**

The Biden Ethics Pledge continues the practice of prohibiting gifts from lobbyists to administration officials. As summarized below, some, but not all, exceptions listed in the broader government ethics gift rules (5 C.F.R. 2635.204) are available to administration officials.
