

## **Comparing Three Presidential Ethics Pledges**

President Biden recently released the Ethics Pledge that will be required of all his appointees. The *Executive Order on Commitments by Executive Branch Personnel* was one of the first 17 Executive Orders issued on Inauguration Day. The following chart provides a brief overview comparing President Biden's Ethics Pledge to that of former Presidents Donald Trump and Barack Obama.
